




Consider Getting A Good Microphone: people will forgive a shaky video BUT if they have to strain to hear you, they will disengage within the first 5 seconds. There is a wide assortment of mics to choose from under a \$100 ... here are some examples:

Lavaliere Mics:

- * AudioTechnica 3350 batter powered mic for approximately \$30.

 The disadvantage is that it runs on a battery and there
 is no power indicator/warning light.
- * SmartMic Lavalier Microphone runs on phantom power, meaning directly from the camera's power supple so no need for a battery.
- * Wireless Lav like the name implies there is no wire connecting you directly to the camera. This allows you to freely walk around (up to 200 ft.) without stumbling over messy cables.

There are a number of reliable paid solutions that offer a host of features/tools that YT does not.













Rule of Thirds: To create aesthetically pleasing shots be sure to frame your subject of the intersection points of where the imaginary horizontal and vertical lines intersect.
